- The *ASCII* column gives the symbol in the Antimoon ASCII Phonetic Alphabet used in Perfect Pronunciation.
- The *IPA* column gives the symbol in the International Phonetic Alphabet (used in most English dictionaries).
- The *N.E.* column gives the letter(s) in the standard alphabet that makes the IPA sound.
- o is zero; l is one. Lowercase L is l. Uppercase Oh is O.
